USGA Course Rating update

Golf SA USGA Course Rating Trainers Ros Brown, Tony Bourne and Bob Crosby will be attending a National Audit & Calibration Exercise in Sydney on Monday 30 November and Tuesday 1 December. A discussion/seminar is also scheduled to take place at the New South Wales Golf Club on Wednesday 2 December.

All attendees will rate three courses over two days. Golf Australia has committed to achieve a successful audit and calibration of Australia's peak course raters.

Following the audit our trainers and raters will be in a position to proceed with the rating of courses in South Australia.

In due course, all clubs will be advised of potential dates for rating together with a list of pre-rating requirements.

Asian Amateur Championships - China

Jordan Sherratt from Thaxted Park has finished T3 on -6 in the inaugural Asian Amateur Championship in southern China, at Mission Hills Golf Club's World Cup Course. In a field of 116 players from 30 Asia Pacific Golf Confederation member countries 3rd place was an outstanding result.

Men's Senior Amateur Championship

The Golf SA Senior Men's Amateur Championship was held over 3 days at the Mount Gambier Golf Club - Monday 2nd November to 4th November 2009, played over 54 holes – 18 holes stroke play each day.

The event was open to male amateur golfers who were 55yrs of age or over, within the handicap limit of 15.4 .

The 2009 Championship, a Golf Australia Senior Men's ranking event, attracted a strong field of forty eight players, from thirty six clubs. Thirty six players were from interstate, including 17 from Victoria and 12 from NSW.

Denis Dale from Asquith Golf Club in NSW, and a two time winner of the Australian Senior Championship and Australian Senior Order of Merit took out the Championship with rounds of 72, 76, 76, finishing +11. Chris Coates from Royal Queensland was 2nd one shot behind and Dave Morrison (Coolangatta) was third on +15. SA's leading player was John Beaumont (Mt Gambier) + 21.

Golf SA representative Neil Brown who was Head Official for the event said that the course was presented in 'outstanding condition' and he had nothing but praise for course Superintendent Brendan Clark, Head Pro Damian Swadling and Club Manager Adam Stevenson and staff for hosting a fabulous 3 day tournament.

The event also gained significant media coverage via The Border Watch, WIN TV, ABC Radio, The Advertiser and various websites.

Membership Attrition & Retention Golf Queensland Study

Golf Queensland has recently completed a study into **Membership Attrition and Retention at Golf Clubs in Queensland**. The Study was undertaken by JBAS www.ibadvisory.com.au one of the leading providers of independent golf advisory services.

Jeff Blunden, the Director of JBAS, created and managed the Golf Advisory Business Unit of Ernst & Young from 2001 to mid-2006, before spending time in roles with both Golf Australia and Troon Golf prior to formally creating JBAS in 2008.

JBAS offers the following Retention Checklist for Clubs:

- Measure attrition on an annual basis. What gets measured gets acted on.
- Communicate to all members on a regular basis
- Measure member rounds frequency
- Communicate direct with members with low frequency
- Survey your members at least every two years
- Consider your membership structures – are they relevant for today's market?
- Conduct resigned member surveys – what are they telling you?
- Conduct new and existing member events – the goal is to add value to the annual fee paid
- Know your market – both the wider population and regional peers
- Ensure you have payment flexibility

- Limit the barrier for transition from Junior to Adult membership
- Incentivise members to introduce new members
